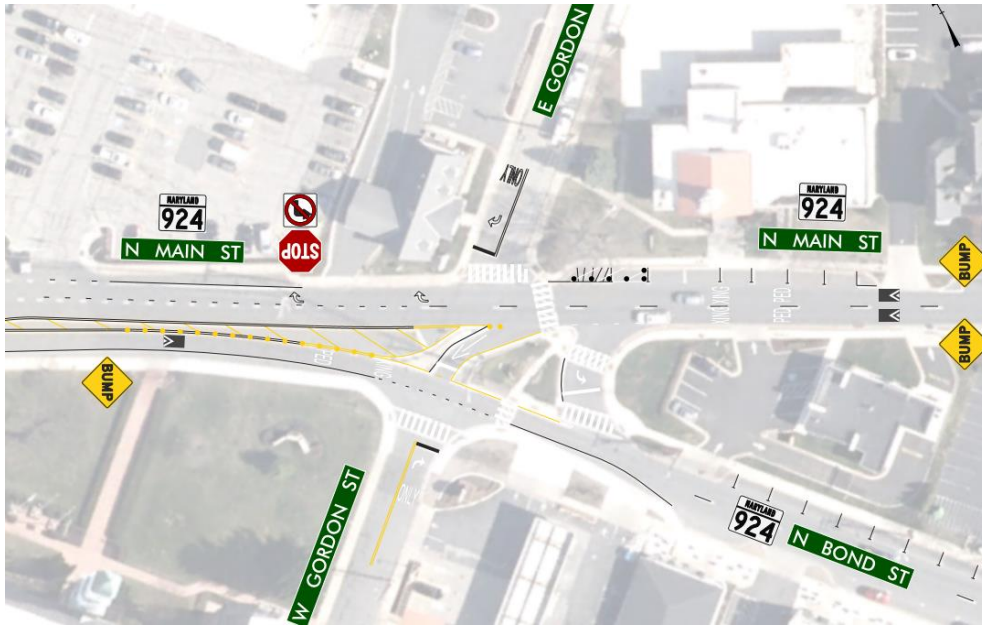

Bel Air Main Street and Bond Street Quick Build Demonstration Project



Main Street from Broadway to Lee Street

While this quick build demonstration project is in place you will see improvements for people crossing Main Street on foot, including speed bumps to slow traffic speeds. **The left turn from Main Street to E Gordon will be temporarily closed.**

The Town of Bel Air is part of the Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) Complete Streets Leadership Academy!

The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) is partnering with Smart Growth America and local jurisdictions to deploy Complete Streets demonstration projects on some state-owned roadways this summer, amid efforts to improve road safety in communities across the state. Communities like the Town of Bel Air will then apply these skills by implementing temporary, on-the-ground demonstration projects.

- The Town of Bel Air received technical assistance and \$22,000 grant to implement this project.
- Project installation will occur this summer. The temporary projects are intended for demonstration purposes only and will be removed by the end of the year.

Bel Air Main Street Quick Build Demonstration Goals

The projects will target dangerous intersections or corridors with a known history of crashes:

- Safety – This project aims to make it safer for people, including students at Bel Air Elementary, to cross Main Street. The project will also make the flat iron area easier to navigate by reducing the number of turns.
- Planning and evaluation – through this temporary project and the data we collect we will consider how to make it easier for people to get to Bel Air Elementary and Main Street businesses on foot.
